The e-HLbc suite of electronic resources includes four premier search indexes, Medline, CINAHL, PsycINFO and Evidence Based Medicine Reviews (EBMR) – which includes the Cochrane databases. These indexes link to 1,700 full text journals.

Health professionals using e-HLbc can improve health outcomes and enhance the quality of care by:

- Accessing current health information
- Searching for evidence to apply in practice
- Identifying evidence based guidelines

Training and ongoing support is primarily provided by the librarians at member institutions.

- The “Smartlink” system allows a patron to have the ability to move from an article citation in an EBSCO database to the full text contained in another licensed EBSCO resource. EBSCO SmartLinks are easily activated via EBSCOadmin.
- The CustomLinks(TM) feature works by allowing links to be calculated using a customer-controlled URL template. Members can create CustomLinks to their linksolver, their own library catalog, interlibrary loan forms, Serial Solutions, document delivery service or A to Z title list.
- Ovid LinkSolver™ is a resource linking solution that can give you complete administrative flexibility in defining, organizing and displaying links for your end-users.
- Ovid A to Z full-text title list generator will help your end users navigate to full-text by browsing title by title or by subject.
