Good afternoon,

I am writing to update eHLbc members on the progress of the Core Suite renewal.

Last fall, the eHLbc Administrative Centre conducted a survey to assess members' satisfaction with the Core Suite, gather suggestions, and confirm member needs regarding communications and decision-making throughout the renewal process.

The survey received an 87% response rate, with 100% of respondents indicating that the current Core Suite meets their organizational needs. While a portion of respondents suggested specific products for potential inclusion in the Core Suite, these suggestions were diverse, and no clear consensus emerged.

Based on this strong support for the Core Suite and with approval from the Management Committee, which reviewed the survey results and renewal plan in late November, the eHLbc Administrative Centre has proceeded with the renewal process. Additionally, the Administrative Centre will investigate whether specific products suggested via the survey are feasible for consortial licensing. Any resources that are deemed feasible for consortial licensing will be investigated as opt-in licensing, as any new resources being added to the Core Suite require unanimous agreement from all participants.

Current Progress:

The Administrative Centre has initiated discussions with vendors regarding pricing and launched the <u>Core Suite Web</u>, a dedicated resource providing timelines, FAQs, and a communications archive to support member organizations in their decision-making processes.

Next Steps:

Moving forward, the Administrative Centre will continue to update the Management Committee on proposed pricing and will share a comprehensive Core Suite proposal with all members once

finalized. As new information, including proposed pricing, becomes available, it will be added to the Core Suite webpages.
