As a reminder, participation in the licensing of the Core Suite is the cornerstone of eHLbc. Affirming your membership means your organization agrees to pay annual subscription costs for the [Core Suite](#) from April 1, 2026 to March 31, 2030, in addition to the annual

membership fee that covers the consortium's administrative costs.

By committing to an ongoing collaborative approach to coordination and licensing, eHLbc members continue to provide BC's health practitioners, researchers, educators and students with equitable access to high quality and cost-effective health information resources.

Select "Core Suite" in the right-hand menu, and the full Core Suite web will be visible. (To view pricing information, select "Proposal Overview" to expand the submenu.)

**2. [The 2026-2030 Case for Renewal](#):** This brief document explains the benefits of the Core Suite and outlines pricing for each member organization over the next four years. It is a useful tool to share with administrators. Please do not share this document outside your organization or with vendors, as it contains confidential pricing information.

**3. [2026-2030 Membership Fees for Full Members](#):** eHLbc membership brings valuable benefits, including significant savings both on critical health resources and on administrative support. The eHLbc Management Committee has reviewed and approved 2026-2030 fees for full members.

Affiliate Members will be contacted separately to confirm membership fees and continued participation in eHLbc.

After receiving responses from all full member organizations, the eHLbc Administrative Centre will provide a January 2026 update on membership. Invoicing for membership and Core Suite fees for the 2026-2030 will commence in the new fiscal year, beginning in April 2026.
