

### eHLbc Administrative Centre Report: July to December 2022

eHLbc reports biannually on achieving goals as outlined in its Strategic Plan.

#### Licensing Infrastructure Support

- Negotiated a low common inflationary renewal increase for ProQuest-licensed resources for 2022; this was accomplished in partnership with other Western consortia and provides stability for member budgets
- Trained and supervised two co-op students on ConsortiaManager and licensing renewals work
- Launched a "ConsortiaManager Tip of the Month" email campaign directed at member licensing staff to provide guidance on maximizing use of ConsortiaManager
- Organized a ConsortiaManager user group meeting within Consortia Canada to discuss issues and solutions for users of the platform
- In conjunction with a contracted license agreement expert, began a project to overhaul and improve existing license agreements and update the eHLbc model license

#### Maintain Core Suite of Resources

- Gathered information on updates to Lippincott Williams & Wilkins (LWW) Perpetual
  Titles List to assist members with EDS Discovery
- Cleaned up Core Suite Web pages for archival purposes; the Core Suite Web captures significant information about the Core Suite renewal, which occurs every 3 to 4 years.

#### **Grow Collection of Boutique Resources**

- Renewed seven boutique resources:
  - Ageline in collaboration with Western Consortia; eHLbc as lead
  - Clinical Skills, including four modules: Core, Pediatric Nursing, Perioperative Nursing, and Respiratory Therapy
  - EBSCO Discovery Service (EDS) in collaboration with BC ELN

- Full Text Finder (EBSCO)
- JBI Database, Journal, and Tools Package in collaboration with Consortia Canada; eHLbc lead
- o SPORTDiscus Full Text: in collaboration with COPPUL
- SPORTDiscus Index: in collaboration with COPPUL

#### **Empower and Support eHLbc Members**

- Hosted the eHLbc Management Committee business meeting in November 2022; minutes available at: https://ehlbc.ca/about/management-committee/minutes
- Management Committee approved an action plan and confirmed a date to host an eHLbc Strategic Framework event for all members in Spring 2023
- Published two issues of the Vital Signs newsletter
- Attended multiple meetings with host site SFU Finance department staff to improve structure and sustainability of eHLbc finances within the SFU system.
- Held eHLbc orientation session for new library directors at Capilano University and Vancouver Community College; shared customized dashboards highlighting eHLbc value for institutions

#### Develop eHLbc's Affiliate Membership

- Refreshed processes and documentation for Affiliate Members on eHLbc website
- Fielded membership inquiry from Yukon Child Development Centre
- Worked with affiliate members Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists BC Chapter and Yukon Health and Social Services to update headcounts and manage resulting infrastructure changes
- Delivered eHLbc orientations for 2 new contacts from Yukon Health and Social Services

- Hosted and facilitated two eHLbc Learning Opportunity sessions for members:
  - October 20, 2022 Using the EBSCOhost Interface for Core Suite Resources
  - October 25, 2022 Using the PICO Search Model Across the EBSCO Core Suite Resources

• Consulted with Management Committee and vendor on a future Learning Opportunity tailored to the BC health context provided by a clinical consultant
